



Below is a suggested itinerary just to give you an idea of the many things to do

Saturday

Arrive from 5pm- After a welcome drink Luis will take you on a tour of the house and explain how everything works
Welcome dinner.

Sunday

Relax by the pool in the morning or perhaps have Jenny deliver you breakfast in bed.
1pm this is a good time for a drink in Fuentespalda's main square and you can watch all the locals coming out of church. It is the time to be seen!
Have a traditional Aragonese Lunch at La Fonda which Luis can arrange for you. Being Spain this will fill most of your day!
Walk off lunch with an early evening stroll around the grounds.
Jenny will provide a light dinner.

Monday

Walk up to La Picoso the highest peak in the area which has stunning views over the lake and surrounding mountains
Make your own lunch back at the masia (Luis could buy your provisions in the morning)
Have siesta in the house as is nice and cool inside.
Relax by the pool in the early evening.
At dusk Luis can show you the best places for spotting the endangered Spanish Ibex which come down to the spring.

Tuesday

Relax at the pool in the morning.
Have a late lunch in la Fresneda at Matarranya restaurant which Luis can book for you.
Have a look around this very well preserved medieval village.
Late afternoon explore the beautiful nearby town of Valderrobres.
From 5pm the castle is open and it is a great place to stroll around followed by a drink in the square.
Have dinner at La Casa de Sebastian which has a wonderful atmosphere and eccentric host.

Wednesday

Mountain biking - follow the track down the mountain to Fuentespalda and then walk along the beautiful river to Relais & Chateaux La Torre del Visco one of the best hotels in Spain where the owners can prepare a gourmet lunch and get you back to the masia for the inevitable siesta.
Dinner at the masia and possible relax watching a film outside.

Thursday

The gorge walk is one of the highlights of a trip here.
Drive to Beceite where the walk begins through dramatic scenery following a river with loads of pools you can swim in.
Lunch in a traditional restaurant in the village.
Afternoon, drive around the lake where water sports can be arranged or just go for a swim.
Dinner and stargazing at the masia

Friday

Relax in at the pool in the morning.
Go to the incredible walled city of Morella for lunch and to explore one of Spain's hidden gems.
On the way back you can visit the incredible rock formations of lo Masmut near Penarroja where you can watch the Griffon vultures.
Dinner at the masia.

Saturday

Probably time for one last quick dip in the pool before leaving.
